Informal Fallacies

An informal fallacy is a fallacy which we cannot diagnose by simply inspecting the argument's form; in order to diagnose the fallacy, we must look additionally to the argument's content Eg, 1 Zoe has more energy than Daniel" 2 Energy is proportional to mass 3 Zoe has more mass than Daniel" 1 x has more F than z 2 F is
